



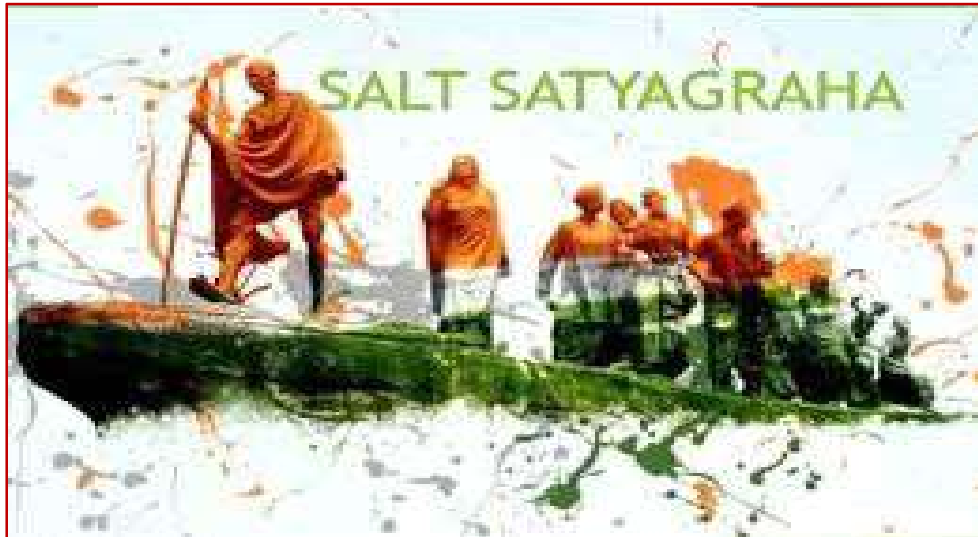

Against the backdrop of today's fierce competition, the race for knowledge and technology, the degradation of nature, the growing desire of man, corruption, immorality, moral degradation, religious rifts, nationalism, increasing urbanization, industrialization, degradation of rural culture. The Gandhian Thoughts Certificate Course was started with the aim of inculcating moral values in the minds of the students while pursuing higher education and making them an ideal citizen.

Gandhian Thoughts is a three-month course which is conducted once in an academic year. The course has been started locally by the college with the help of the institute and no fee is charged from the participating students for this certificate course.
